Criteria for Awards

Application Deadline: April 22, 2019

Scholarship winners will be presented at the CCBUCC service on Sunday, May 19, 2019

A Scholarship is awarded to a student who:

1. Is a current member of CCBUCC and has attended CCBUCC for the three (3) consecutive years preceding the application; and
2. Is active in church activities and any of the following: community service activities, extracurricular activities, or is working to pay for his/her education; and
3. Will be attending a traditional two or four-year undergraduate college or trade school.

Applicant must supply evidence of high school graduation and acceptance at a two or four-year undergraduate college or trade school.

Previous year’s winners are invited to submit an application for renewal of the scholarship. This is a shorter form that requests information about activities at the student’s college or university and other community activities.
